Active Ingredient Prescribing

Medications that are on the List of Excluded Medicinal Items (LEMI) and List of Medicines for Brand Consideration (LMBC) for AIP are flagged in MIMS database

PBS and Authority Information

Pharmaceutical benefits information for medicines that are part of the Pharmaceutical Benefit
Scheme including any authority details, updated monthly on MIMS database

Updated Medicines Product Information and CMIs

- **Product Information** TGA approved product information for clinicians
- Consumer Medicines Information (CMI) Patient handouts that include general medicines information, such as the use of medication, how to take the medicine and side effects
- MIMS Abbreviated Product Information Product summary prepared by MIMS editorial team including indications, precautions and dosage
- **TGA programs** MIMS includes Black Triangle Adverse event reporting, the full Product Information and CMI in the new format
